

Bremen City Schools
Called Board of Education Meeting
July 21, 2010

The Bremen Board of Education met in a called session at the Warren Sewell Administration Building on Wednesday, July 21, 2010, at 7:30 a.m. for the purpose of dealing with the budget (mill rate) and personnel. All board members were present.

As a result of a new City of Bremen charter being approved by the city which establishes and recognizes the authority of the Bremen City Schools Board of Education, it was necessary that each Board of Education member be re-sworn into office. Judge Eddie Hulsey conducted the oath of office.

On a recommendation from the Superintendent, the Board of Education approved advertising of the millage rate at a rate for both Haralson and Carroll of 14.950 (Motion: Mr. Rob Walker, Second: Mr. Vann Pelt, vote 5-0). Including fiscal year 2011, this rate has remained the same for the last three years. The board also unanimously approved amending the 2010-2011 school system budget as a result of changes in anticipated tax revenue (Motion: Mr. Rob Walker, Second: Mr. Gordon Parrish, vote 5-0).

The board voted to go into executive session to discuss personnel (Motion: Mr. Daryl Sellers, Second: Mr. Brandall Lovvorn, vote 5-0). Upon voting to exit executive session (Motion: Mr. Rob Walker, Second: Mr. Brandall Lovvorn, vote 5-0), the board unanimously approved the following: The resignation of Mr. David Clay, Social Studies Teacher – Bremen High School (Motion: Mr. Vann Pelt, Second: Mr. Brandall Lovvorn, vote 5-0) and the recommendation to hire Mr. Josh Carter as Social Studies Teacher at Bremen High School, Mrs. Kristina Richardson as a Special Education Teacher at Bremen High School and Mrs. Linda Tuggle, Long-Term Substitute for Mrs. Laura Johncox at Bremen Academy (Motion: Mr. Rob Walker, Second: Mr. Brandall Lovvorn, vote 5-0).

With no further business before the board, Mr. Daryl Sellers, Board Chairman, adjourned the meeting.
